

Volunteer at the World Vision Warehouse in Miami!

World Vision is a Christian humanitarian organization dedicated to working with children, families, and their communities worldwide to reach their full potential by tackling the causes of poverty and injustice.

For nearly 60 years, World Vision has provided emergency relief, long-term development and advocacy to nearly 100 countries around the world. But we don't do it alone. **Volunteers** continue to be an invaluable asset to World Vision. Not only do volunteers provide much needed help, but they bring energy and creativity to our work. Their service is an incredible encouragement to staff.

What do volunteers do?

Volunteers will help sort and package products such as personal hygiene kits that will be sent to Haiti to help children and families affected by the earthquake. Volunteers also help with warehouse activities such as trash removal, pallets, lifting and building boxes.

All volunteers and agencies are required to sign a waiver release form and will agree to comply with all World Vision policies. Volunteers must be able to sort, count and package products such as personal hygiene kits and other material items, as well as to being able to stand for long periods of time, bend, and lift boxes/products up to 50 pounds.

Can a group volunteer?

Yes, groups, anywhere from 3 to 100 people, are welcome to participate in volunteering at the warehouse. Volunteers in groups must be at least 11 years old, and there must be adequate adult supervisor for volunteers under the age of 18 (see minimum age requirements). All group volunteers must schedule an appointment to volunteer by emailing volunteermiami@worldvision.org.

Times for group volunteering are: *Tuesday–Saturday from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm, and Wednesday from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm.*

Can individuals volunteer?

Yes, individuals can either join a group to volunteer, or apply for an ongoing volunteer role. To learn more about available groups or individual opportunities, please email volunteermiami@worldvision.org.

Age Requirements:

Volunteers in a group must be at least 11 years old, and individual volunteers must be at least 16 years old. There must be at least 2 adult for every 30 volunteers under the age of eighteen and 1 adult for every 8 volunteers with special needs.

Appropriate Attire: Volunteers should wear casual, modest clothing they don't mind getting dirty. Footwear must be closed toe shoes.

Lunch Breaks / Personal Items: Volunteers are welcome to eat in our facility, and may store food in our kitchen/refrigerator. **BRING** a water bottle or your own beverage. World Vision is not responsible for any items brought into our facility.
