Royal Caribbean International's FAQs

- ✓ ***How many guests per cabin?***
Staterooms for this two-night charity cruise are being offered as double occupancy. There are a limited number of triple and quad staterooms available for guests wishing to sail with their children, 21 years and younger. These will be granted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- ✓ ***Is there a fee for an additional cabin guest?***
Yes, each additional guest in a stateroom will incur an added charge of \$150.
- ✓ ***Can my infant child sail with me? What is Royal Caribbean International's age policy?***
Yes, providing there are available triple and quad staterooms at the time of your purchase. The minimum age for sailing is 6 months old.
- ✓ ***Is there an additional cost for children (6 months and older)?***
Yes, each additional guest in a stateroom will incur an added charge of \$150.
- ✓ ***Will Kids Club be available?***
Yes, Kids Club will be available when the ship is sailing.
- ✓ ***Can I cruise if I am pregnant?***
Royal Caribbean International cannot accept guests who will have entered their 24th week of pregnancy by the beginning of, or at any time during the cruise. All guests are required to sign a health questionnaire at check-in to ensure they are aware of the cruise line's pregnancy policy.
- ✓ ***Do I have to wear formal attire for the dinners on Thursday and Friday night?***
The attire for the sailing is casual chic – no formal dress required. The official naming ceremony will take place on Thursday, November 15, prior to sailing and those involved will be in business attire. If you wish to attend the naming ceremony, you may want to consider dressing accordingly.
- ✓ ***Can I bring liquor or non-alcoholic beverages (from home or from port) onboard?***
No, and there is no need as all beverages, alcoholic and non-alcoholic, are complimentary on this two-night charity cruise.
- ✓ ***Is smoking allowed on the ship?***
Yes, there are designated smoking areas.
- ✓ ***Is Internet access available from the ship?***
Royal Caribbean VOOM, the fastest Internet at sea, will be available free of charge.
- ✓ ***Which activities will be available on the ship?***
At the moment we anticipate that most, if not all, activities on the ship will be available at some time during the two-day sailing. Since this sailing will also include the ship's naming, some venues may be closed for a short period of time for private functions.
- ✓ ***Can I register for onsite ship activities in advance (spa, zip line, laser tag, FlowRider® surf simulator, rock climbing wall, Escape the Rubicon, etc)?***
Guests can make reservations once onboard.

✓ ***Will the ship dock at a port? If so, for how long?***

The ship is scheduled to dock in Nassau, Bahamas on Friday, November 16 from approximately noon to 5 pm. All guests will have the option to disembark and explore the island, if they so desire.

✓ ***Will there be excursion options in Nassau?***

Yes, Royal Caribbean International is waiting on a list of excursions available and information on possible advance booking.

✓ ***Will the shipboard shops and casino be open?***

Yes, the shops and casino will open once the ship enters international waters and will remain open while at sea. They will be closed while the ship is in port and as it exits international waters.

✓ ***Can I use cash to purchase items on board?***

No, the ship uses a cashless system. As part of the check-in process, you will be required to supply a credit card. All shipboard purchases (in the stores, at the spa, etc.) will be charged to your credit card.

✓ ***Can I make a reservation at one of the specialty restaurants?***

Due to the fact that this is the ship's official naming voyage, the specialty restaurants will be closed to private functions.

✓ ***NO refunds, cancellations or changes to cabin registrations are permitted.***
